Created by physician Dr. Maria Montessori in the late 19th century, the Montessori approach to education centers the child's natural desire to learn, fostering a collaborative environment in which instructors observe and support the child's pursuit of learning. Like a toddler learning to speak, Dr. Montessori believed that authentic learning results from the natural curiosity of a child's mind, more than the regimented imparting of facts.

Today, there are around 5,000 Montessori schools in the US alone, a movement and tradition of which we are proud to be part.

MLK Montessori School was created by three Fort Wayne women — Dottie Fitchey, Dorothy Holt, and Mary Hoban — in the wake of Dr. Martin Luther King Jr.'s assassination as a way to turn something tragic into something beneficial.

What started in 1968 as a small school of 18 children has grown to be able to serve over 100 children from pre-school to third grade.
